



Canada has the highest per capita immigration rate in the world. More than 20 per cent of the Canadian population was born abroad. 25 to 44 is the most common age at which immigrants arrived:

- Children and youth (under 15): 27%
- Young adults (15 to 24): 23%
- Adults (25 to 44): 41%
- Older adults (45+): 9%

In 2011, about 6,042,200 foreign-born people in Canada were eligible to acquire citizenship. Of these, just over 5,175,100, or 85.6%, reported that they had acquired Canadian citizenship.
